Since their formation in 1976, the Friends have raised funds towards the conservation of significant artworks within the Gallery's Collection, including works by Tom Roberts and Nicholas Habbe.

The Friends are also committed to nurturing emerging artistic talent in the local community, developing fundraising campaigns to provide annual bursaries for outstanding Year 11 visual art students in Bendigo (previous recipients include students from Bendigo Senior Secondary College, Catholic College Bendigo, Girton Grammar School and Victorian Christian College).
